

Polish is the primary language of instruction, except for the Doctoral School and the MFA in Visual Arts programs, which are conducted in English.

The Eugeniusz Geppert Academy of Art and Design in Wrocław received Substantial Equivalency by NASAD – the National Association of Schools of Art and Design, an accrediting organization for art schools in the United States. This is the highest recommendation that an art academy outside of the United States can achieve and we are the only art academy in Europe that achieved it.

NASAD sets the standard for Bachelor's, Master's, and doctoral degrees, which means that our diplomas are now recognized as equivalent to some of the best ones in the world.





# **Art and Design of Glass**

We encourage students to explore the materials, processes, technologies, and context of their 3D creations.

We are the only glass and ceramics faculty in Poland and our Academy boasts the most modern facilities in Europe. The study programme is developed in collaboration with high profile international guests who also work with our students in their stu-

While studying here, students become familiar with various techniques such as cold working, casting, stained glass and painting with glass enamel, torch working, hot glass sculpting, and blowing. # Conservation and Restoration of Artworks in specialization of Conservation and Restoration of Ceramics and Glass

The aim of this programme is to prepare fully independent specialists in the field of conservation and restoration of ceramics and glass, who are fully aware of the newest tendencies of art as well as its history.

Our students learn not only about the history of art, philosophy, and archae-

ology but also sociology, chemistry, and physics. They get to know technologies of designing and making ceramics, and glass as well as conservation methods of art and ceramics heritage. The programme allows them to take part in internships programmes and work with local factories and artists.



# **Stage Design**

Puppet theatre opens completely new fields of artistic expression for visual artists. It allows free creation of imaginary worlds and characters that are later brought to life onstage with animation. With movement, as one of its primary means of expression, a puppet becomes a unique work of moving art. It is an object designed for precise manipulation by animators. Our students

learn about a variety of classical and contemporary puppet styles and their stage possibilities. They gain a deeper understanding of design choices and their influence on the performance as a whole. We encourage the search for different visual and technological solutions to broaden the means of expression of each puppet and its environment.


# **Drawing**

The uniqueness of education in the field of drawing lies in the exclusive possibility of shaping and expanding the study programme according to the student's own needs and professional plans. The basic programme is supplemented by subjects selected from the entire educational offer of the Academy.

Our students are introduced to the broad aspects of artistic, anatomical, and perspective drawing as well as drawing-related activities. They receive training in advanced drawing technologies and learn about professional drawing.

This programme gives the students the opportunity to define themselves as a professional draughtsman – an artist functioning in the gallery circuit and on the art market, a professional undertaking collaborative or individual, commercial work.

Graduates are prepared for employment in the professional market. They learn the basics of issues such as comics, drawing in video games, storyboarding, press drawing, illustration, and acquiring knowledge of copyright law, the functioning of the art market, and commercial activities.



# **Painting**

For decades, the word "painting" was a synonym for fine art. Today, it is one of the most popular means of artistic expression, respected and appreciated by artists, critics, and viewers alike. No matter what revolutions appear in modern art, painting (together with drawing) remains the base of artistic education. While studying painting our students develop understanding of colour, surface, and space as well as composition and texture. Our students freely choose painting studios run by

artists with various visions of painting, teaching, and artistic thinking. Our "master-student" relation model is designed to produce the most successful results. We support our students with both technological knowledge and a wide understanding of current and past artistic movements. A thorough understanding of craft, based on extensive academic knowledge, enables our students to become modern and open-minded painters.

# **Sculpture**

Sculpture as a field of study, offers a programme that encompasses both traditional and contemporary methods. Our students have the opportunity to work in sculpture workshops equipped with professional machinery. Equipment and the technical knowledge available in the studios of wood, metal, casting, renovation, and intermedia are among the best in Poland. The students still work using clay

and life models, while simultaneously studying sculpture in the environment of architecture and urban planning. Additionally, they take part in open-air workshops.

Shaping a block or a solid figure and incorporating it into its surroundings is the basic foundation of sculpture, but at the same time, the biggest challenge.

#### **MFA in Visual Arts**

The full-time MFA in Visual Arts is a multi-faceted programme of study taught by all faculties of the Academy, based on the student's individual learning path, tailored to their aptitude and interests. The degree programme lasts two years (4 semesters) and prepares student for a Master's degree.

From the academic year 2022/23, the Eugeniusz Geppert Academy of Art and Design in Wrocław offers one master's degree place with a new double diploma path in a partnership with Tokyo University of the Arts, Japan. The double degree programme is aimed at candidates specialising in printmaking. Students qualified for the programme will complete two semesters in Poland and two in Japan. By fulfilling the requirements of both institutions, the student will be able to receive two diplomas:

- The Eugeniusz Geppert Academy of Art and Design in Wrocław MFA in Visual Arts,
- Tokyo University of the Arts, MFA in Graphic Arts.

#### **Doctoral School**

The Doctoral School of the Eugeniusz Geppert Academy of Art and Design in Wrocław is an artistic and research unit, educating specialists demonstrating significant artistic achievements as well as high research and teaching potential. The doctoral training, which lasts 6 semesters, prepares the researchers to obtain a doctoral degree in the field of art in the discipline of fine arts and conservation of works of art.

#### Characteristics of our Doctoral School:

- The curriculum of the Doctoral School maintains a balance between practice and theory, respect for tradition, and openness to new trends, attachment to classical techniques and experimentation with new technologies.
- The Doctoral School at the Eugeniusz Geppert Academy Art and Design in Wrocław is the only unit of its kind at Polish art academies that provides education entirely in English. As of the 2022/2023 academic year, a parallel mode of education in Polish has also been launched.
- PhD students from all over the world study at the Doctoral School, including countries such as Austria, Brazil, China, Greece, Iran, Mexico, Romania, Slovakia, Sweden, Turkey, and the United Kingdom.
- Our PhD students actively participate in the life of the international artistic and scientific community, taking an active part in exhibitions, competitions, residencies, symposia, and conferences, carrying out research and implementation projects and publishing texts in specialist journals and scientific monographs.
- In accordance with the Law on Higher Education and Science (of 20 July 2018), all PhD students at Polish doctoral schools receive high monthly scholarships (which are further increased after passing the mid-term evaluation). In addition, in the case of the Doctoral School at our Academy, some foreign doctoral students receive increased scholarships within the STER programme, funded by the National Agency for Academic Exchange.



## **Enrolment step by step**

#### Step 1

- Register at our on-line Enrolment System,
- Complete an on-line application form.
- Upload your portfolio (up to 20 works),
- Upload scanned copies of the documents required:
  - identity card or passport;
  - document confirming the knowledge of the English language proficiency at minimum B2 level;
  - diploma of higher education (BA or MA) and a document confirming the course of studies (a transcript of subjects and grades, a supplement to the diploma or a student's record book).

Remember! All foreign graduation diplomas must be accompanied by an apostille or legalized! Diplomas, transcripts

and certificates issued in a language other than Polish or English have to be translated into the Polish language by a Polish sworn translator.

#### Step 2

The Recruitment Board analyses uploaded documents and issues a decision.


#### Step 3

You need to provide the originals of the above documents and some additional information, such as:


- a scanned copy of a health insurance policy,
