## **TYPES OF DOCUMENTS CERTIFYING PROFICIENCY IN A FOREIGN LANGUAGE AT A LEVEL NOT LOWER THAN B2**

Documents certifying proficiency in a foreign language at a level not lower than B2 include:

1. **A certificate, diploma, or other document** confirming proficiency in a given foreign language in all four language skills—listening comprehension, reading, speaking, and writing—at the B2, C1, or C2 level, issued by one of the following institutions:

**For the English language:**

- **University of Cambridge, ESOL Examinations:**
  - B2 First (FCE),
  - C1 Advanced (CAE),
  - C2 Proficiency (CPE),
  - B2 Business Vantage (BEC Vantage),
  - C1 Business Higher,
  - Certificate in English for International Business and Trade (CEIBT);
- **University of Cambridge, ESOL Examinations; British Council; IDP IELTS Australia:**
  - International English Language Testing System (IELTS) – a minimum overall score of 5.5;
- **Trinity College London:**
  - ESOL Skills for Life – Level 1 (B2) or higher,
  - Integrated Skills in English (ISE) – ISE II or higher,
  - ISE Digital – above 80 points (B2);
- **Educational Testing Service (ETS):**
  - Test of English as a Foreign Language, Internet-Based Test (TOEFL iBT) – a minimum score of 72,
  - Test of English for International Communication (TOEIC) – at least:
    - 785 points in Listening & Reading,
    - 150 points in Speaking,
    - 160 points in Writing;
- **Pearson Assessment English:**

- Pearson English International Certificate – paper-based or computer-based (formerly Pearson Test of English General (PTE) or London Tests of English) – Level 3 (Edexcel Certificate in ESOL International Level 1 – Pass, Merit, or Distinction) or higher,
  - Pearson Test of English Academic (PTE Academic), both test-centre and online versions – a minimum score of 59;
- **LanguageCert (PeopleCert Qualifications – PCQ):**
  - LanguageCert International ESOL – LanguageCert Level 1 Certificate in ESOL International (Listening, Reading, Writing) (Communicator B2), also known as LanguageCert International ESOL Communicator B2 Listening, Reading, Writing, or higher, together with LanguageCert Level 1 Certificate in ESOL International (Speaking) (Communicator B2), also known as LanguageCert International ESOL Communicator B2 Speaking, or higher;
  - LanguageCert Academic – LanguageCert Level 1 Certificate in ESOL International (Listening, Reading, Writing, Speaking) (LanguageCert Academic B2) or higher;
  - LanguageCert Test of English – LanguageCert Level 1 Certificate in ESOL International (Listening, Reading, Writing, Speaking) (LanguageCert Test of English B2) or higher;
- **Education Development International (EDI); London Chamber of Commerce and Industry Examinations Board (LCCI):**
  - English for Business Level 2 or higher,
  - Foundation Certificate for Teachers of Business English (FTBE);
- **European Consortium for the Certificate of Attainment in Modern Languages:**
  - Level B2 (Vantage) or higher;
- **Telc GmbH; WBT Weiterbildungs-Testsysteme GmbH:**
  - Certificate in English,
  - Certificate in English for Business Purposes,
  - Certificate in English for Technical Purposes,
  - telc English,
  - telc English Business,
  - telc English Technical,
  - telc English University.
2. **A certificate of completion of a preparatory course for undertaking studies,** referred to in Article 60(4) of the Act of 12 December 2013 on Foreigners, with a duration of not less than 9 months, confirming proficiency in a given foreign language

in all four language skills—listening comprehension, reading, speaking, and writing—at the B2, C1, or C2 level.

3. **A diploma of completion of first-cycle (Bachelor's), second-cycle (Master's), or long-cycle Master's degree studies** in philology in the relevant foreign language or in applied linguistics, issued by a higher education institution operating within the higher education and science system of the Republic of Poland or by a foreign higher education institution, together with a diploma supplement or a certificate confirming that the number of contact hours in the relevant foreign language was at least 500.
4. **A diploma of completion of first-cycle (Bachelor's), second-cycle (Master's), or long-cycle Master's degree studies** issued by a higher education institution operating within the higher education and science system of the Republic of Poland or by a foreign higher education institution, containing information on the language of instruction; where the diploma does not contain such information, a diploma supplement or an additional certificate indicating the language of instruction is required.
5. **An International Baccalaureate Diploma** – with regard to the language taken at the standard (primary) level.
6. **A European Baccalaureate Diploma** – with regard to the first language (L1) or second language (L2).
7. **A certificate confirming authorization to practise as a sworn translator** of the relevant foreign language, issued by the Minister of Justice pursuant to Article 5(2) of the Act of 25 November 2004 on the Profession of Sworn Translator, or a certificate confirming entry on the list of sworn translators for the relevant foreign language.
